PASTORS CORNER

Mark 6:1-6

"1 Jesus left that part of the country and returned with his disciples to Nazareth, his hometown. 2 The next Sabbath he began teaching in the synagogue, and many who heard him were amazed. They asked, "Where did he get all this wisdom and the power to perform such miracles?" 3 Then they scoffed, "He's just a carpenter, the son of Mary and the brother of James, Joseph, Judas, and Simon. And his sisters live right here among us." They were deeply offended and refused to believe in him.

⁴Then Jesus told them, "A prophet is honored everywhere except in his own hometown and among his relatives and his own family." ⁵ And because of their unbelief, he couldn't do any miracles among them except to place his hands on a few sick people and heal them.
⁶ And he was amazed at their unbelief."

The people from Jesus' hometown were offended at him when he performed miracles and taught with wisdom and authority. They could not fathom that God could powerfully use someone who had grown up in their town. Their unbelief limited what God could do among them.

We must remember the warning from Hebrews 3:12-13:

"12 Be careful then, dear brothers and sisters. Make sure that your own hearts are not evil and unbelieving, turning you away from the living God. 13 You must warn each other every day, while it is still "today," so that none of you will be deceived by sin and hardened against God. God can use whoever he wants, whenever he wants. May we not limit God through unbelief and hardness of heart."

Luke 21:29-33 He told them this parable: "Look at the fig tree and all the



We leave June 8th! There are 19 of us - 9 adults and 10 children ages 9, 9, 10 (Tessa), 11, 12 (Heidi), 12, 14, 15, 16 and 18.

Will you pray for us?

- That the fruit of this trip is that people have clean water and have hearts cleaned by Jesus, that God's life-giving purposes are accomplished.
- The details of the mission will come together in a way that glorifies God.
- God will be preparing the hearts of those our group will be sharing to hear grace and the truth of the Gospel.
- We will walk by faith and be empowered by the Holy Spirit.
- That our team will have supernatural love and unity.
- For the children to feel loved by God and their parents, to process the experience through the lens of hope, and to step into specific ways that open up for them to participate.
- God will lead us in our transition back to the US, as there could be weariness and many mixed emotions.
