


POLK COUNTY FAIR

Leadership Teams Minutes June 10, 2024

The meeting was called to order at 6 pm by Lucas. Jacob led the devotional about keeping our eyes on the prize—yield to God's will as He has the bigger picture—seek God in every aspect of life and follow his lead to his perfect will. Lucas prayed.

The agenda and last month's meeting minutes were motioned to be accepted by Tim, seconded by Jacob. Motion passed with no objections.

Financial report for May was reviewed. Motion by Jacob to accept. Seconded by Cindee. Motion passed with no objections.

Old Business. Ridgeview update by Tim in which he stated that things are going well. Confirmed the closing and disbursing of the Solid Rock funds to the four LBBC summer staff.

New Business: the church was asked if we would share information about a fund-raising booth that will be at Clear Lake Days. Information will be placed in the bulletin. There was discussion about holding a special offering for C.E.F. Josh is going to follow up with Wendy D. There was discussion of the need for two services as God continues to add people to our church. There was also discussion of the possible need to start Life Groups or Small Groups to help with community connections. The leadership team previously met with two companies regarding the next step in building expansion. Pros and Cons of each company were discussed. The leadership team's recommendation for the next step will be presented at the semi-annual meeting. The church has been approached about hosting a Word and Spirit conference by Remnant Radio. This is being prayerfully considered. No decision was made.

Youth report: the summer schedule is out. VBS is underway soon. There is a tubing day planned for July 3rd down the Apple River. The Chicago mission trip has three adults and six youth going. The approximate cost is \$450 each. Not all needed funds have been raised yet.

Next meeting is scheduled for July 10th at 6 p.m. The Semi-annual meeting is set for July 14th.
