October 7, 2024: Leadership Team Notes

Call to Order, Devotions and Prayer. Lucas called the meeting to order. Jacob led devotions from the Jude 1:3. Beware of false prophets. Urge each other to stand strong in faith and steadfast to the Gospel. Jacob prayed.

Agenda and last month's meeting minutes. Tim motioned to accept; Emily seconded. Motion passed with no objections.

Finance Report was reviewed. No questions.

Youth Report. The report was submitted to the Leadership Team via email by Youth Pastor Josh Williamson. Youth report from Josh via email:

Words are not able to express how much of a blessing each week has already been with our Fall schedule. We have had over fifty junior high and high school kids each Wednesday night, and we have had over twenty-five high school students each week of Sunday School. With the growth we have continued to see, I will be reaching out for some additional Wednesday night volunteers to help supervise our kids and keep them safe.

I am very impressed with the Alpha Youth curriculum that we have been using on Wednesday nights, and I've heard some really good discussion coming from it. Our Sunday School class has also been covering challenging questions such as "What is the unforgivable sin?" and "What does the Bible say about piercings?", or "How did people before Jesus have a path to heaven?" This next week we are discussing Halloween. I love seeing our youth going to the Bible to answer these challenging questions, and my request has been to have parents walk through these studies with them.

Coming up is our Underground Church event on October 19th with several other area churches. Also, our Youth Fall Retreat will be from Oct 25-27th at Lake Beauty!

Burt motioned to accept both the finance and the youth report. Tim seconded. Motion passed.

Old Business

- Two Service Discussion: Ministry meeting held 10/8/2024. We prayed for the transition.
- Station 19 Progress: Nothing new as the next workshop is 10/14/2024.
- Highway 63 Sign Update (from Josh via email): We have received payments from: St. John's Catholic Church; Grace Lutheran Church; Reeve Evangelical Free; Josh has received confirmation that payment is coming from Holy Trinity Orthodox. Josh has also: 1) spoken with Libby Higgins from Living Word Chapel and is waiting for

confirmation from them; 2) left multiple voicemails and emails for the Seventh Day Adventist Church, Moe Lutheran, and United Methodist with no returned response and 3) not been able to make any contact with the St. Barnabas Anglican church. He inquired via email if anyone on the LT has a contact for this church. The goal is to have the sign completed before winter.

New Business

- Financial Decisions. Discussed adding to the annual budgeting discussion, the church setting aside an emergency fund.
